This forest worker overall is best suited for semi-professional **forest work in easy terrain, including on forest roads, for example: private firewood harvesting, road maintenance work, horticulture and agriculture** etc.

The overall was worn for a total of 233 days during the test.

➤ Quality/Features	The pockets are only located on belly, this causes problems when using a belt, the only stowage place for the first aid kit is the belly pocket	O
➤ Durability	Durability of the jacket is typical for this fabric without reinforcements. The zipper was described as too weak.	O
➤ Care	Easy to care when following manufacturers recommendations.	O
➤ Type and function	The type and function of the jacket were rated good to satisfactory.	+/O

Test results for the trousers:

➤ Comfort	Comfort was rated between good and satisfactory. The elastic waist of the bib trousers made a positive impression.	+/O
	According to the test persons the comfort-rating for these trousers, which display the classic characteristics of a cotton / polyester mixed fabric, is satisfactory.	O
➤ Quality/Features	Quality and features were rated good to satisfactory; test persons noted a tendency for sawdust to accumulate in the trouser pockets.	+/O
➤ Durability	The durability-rating of the product is good to satisfactory. The upper material is easy to access for repairs, because the cut protection material is not sewn to the stitching..	+/O
➤ Care	The test persons found it easy to care of the trousers according to manufacturers recommendations. The approved washing temperature is higher than that of the Jacket.	+/O
➤ Type and function	The type and function of the jacket were rated satisfactory.	O

Material / data

Material

Upper material made of highly tear resistant, lightweight and durable mixed fabric.

Function

Jacket with signal colours on shoulder and upper arms; two belly pockets, one with small flap and zipper. No inner pockets. Ventlated back, one-way zipper at the front. 50% cotton, 50 % polyester in the upper part and 93 % Nylon, 7% Spandex in the lower part, washable at 40°C.

Trousers and bib trousers with DPLF (KWF) approved class I cut protection (Test no.: -Nr. K-EG 2011/6018); Bib and standard trousers available, green or blue. Rear elastic drawcord. Two pockets with angled opening, no fasteners, one rear pocket with flap and velcro fastener, tool pocket, small elastic gusset for more freedom of movement . 33% cotton, 67 % polyester, washable at 40°C. The suit is also available with 100 % polyester and 50 % polyester, 50 % cotton.

Thew trouser 21-022 (Flex) is equipped similar to the jackets with 93% Nylon and 7% Spandex in some parts for a better movability and an additional front reinforcement for a better durability and usability.
